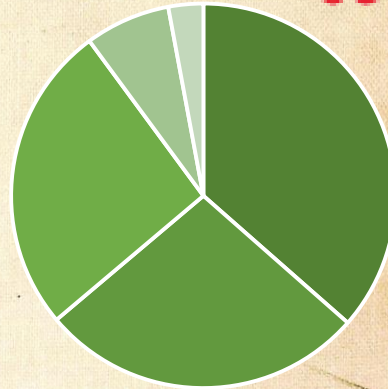

OFFICE OF CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS, 20TH DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF NAVAL COMMUNICATIONS, SECTION G / COMMUNICATIONS SECURITY

Referred to as "OP-20-G" for short, this is the United States Naval cryptanalysis and signal corps. Consisting entirely of high-ranking US naval officers and admiralty, the goals of this sponsor are largely to extend United States operational capability in the Pacific Ocean. To this end, the organization is strongly in favor of development of weapons and covert utilities. Most of the officers subscribe to Wilsonianism, a policy which suggests interventionism in other countries to spread democracy, stop the spread of Communism, and advance United States imperial interests. They will support expenses which can be justified as militarily useful, structural fortifications and defenses, and projects which will support spying and espionage, particularly on Communist Asian nations such as the PRC.

ILLUMINATED ORDER OF THE ODDFELLOWS

The organization the least is known about. Ostensibly a charitable organization with uncertain revenue streams, numerous hospitals, homeless shelters, and soup kitchens have been built in their name. Their membership seems inconsistent, other than that all members seem to be important and influential members of their respective societies. Multinational, and highly secretive. They tend to have highly Communist leanings and believe that the poor do not have the proper education to make the choices most beneficial to them.

They are very interested in the advancement of esoteric research, particularly into psychology, animal training, and biology. They also desire that any unidentified artifacts found near the lab be sold to them for placement in museums after restoration, although the veracity of these claims is uncertain.

SOCIETY OF JESUS

Known as the "Jesuits", they have been referred to as "God's Marines". This Catholic monastic order is active in more than one hundred nations, and brothers are expected to accept orders even in extreme conditions. Orders such as the Jesuits and Franciscans were among the most important contributors to science centuries ago, and most of modern seismology and much of physics is attributable to their research. Believing that understanding the world will bring us closer to understanding the God who created it, Jesuits will back almost any research project that isn't military related. They also are broadly supportive of medical research and construction.

Their conviction for science is only exceeded by their religious faith. Catholic moralists, they will disapprove of a policy of secularism and will not tolerate a policy of state atheism.

ISTANA

Currently our smallest financial backer, but a backer nonetheless. Composed of wealthy upper class merchants of largely Chinese ethnic background, they chafe under British rule in Singapore. Istana is interested in Sealab as a business opportunity and will back projects into the research of trade commodities. They are strongly anti-British and hope to leverage new alliances in order to secure Singapore's independence.

ANNUAL REVIEW & FORESIGHT COMMISSION

In spite of the highly inhospitable location, we have met our construction goals for the year. Establishing a wide base of foundations was necessary in order to expand with the arrival of staff this year. Our expenses were entirely on contracting services this year, and we built only foundations, opting to leave further plans for expansion until after the arrival of dedicated engineering staff.



In the coming year, we face many challenges. With the increasing instability of politics across the globe, we have been forced to call for our most important staff to immediately embark the lab before construction could be completed. Ongoing wars both in Europe and Asia threaten to engulf the world and cost the lives of countless great thinkers. Starting this year, we will need to worry about salaries and sustainability. Decisions regarding how to pay staff and how to maintain the livability of conditions will be paramount for establishing our long-term survival. We have currently not been assigned a strategic goal to analyze.

Due to a lack of staff this year, there are no reports on department efficiency. At the end of the year, we had 0 staff members employed. We had no staff to survey this year, but based on the comfort level of the habitat, we would expect their comfort level to be **extremely low**.

We have no trade agreements and earned nothing on trade this year.

We had no medical crises this year.

The council is in good standing with the Board of Trustees. There have been no deaths on the board this year. The current controller of the board is the GfMK. The sitting president of the board is James Wilkes.
